Cairns, Great Barrier Reef, Sydney; Te Anau, Arrowtown, Queenstown, Rotorua, Auckland **Early September 2026**

Come with us on the journey of a lifetime as we explore the wonders of Australia and New Zealand. *We'll fly to beautiful Sydney or Brisbane, then on to Cairnes. There we'll experience Australia's iconic wildlife, including koalas, kangaroos, and crocodiles by both land and boat. On the next day, board a high-speed catamaran to the Great Barrier Marine Park — a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World. At the outer reef, you can swim or snorkel, or behold the underwater world from the lower deck of the stationary pontoon.*

Later, at Rainforestation Nature Park, you'll enjoy a Pamagirri Aboriginal dance performance and learn how didgeridoos are made and used in ceremonies. Then in Sydney, enjoy a guided tour of the famous Opera House.

In New Zealand, you'll visit the shores of Lake Te Anau, the South Island's largest lake with a majestic backdrop of Mount Luxmore and the Murchison mountains. Then cruise Milford Sound, hailed by Rudyard Kipling as the "Eighth Wonder of the World." Rest on the next day, or take an optional jet boat tour on the Upper Waiau River, taking in the wilderness of Fiordland National Park, and visiting a few of the locations used in the filming of The Lord of the Rings.

Then board the TSS Earnslaw, a historic steamship that first launched in 1912. Cruise across Lake Wakatipu to Walter Peak Sheep Station for a guided farm tour. After arriving in Rotorua, a small city known for its Maori culture and natural thermal pools, you'll check into your hotel and enjoy some time to unwind. You'll conclude your tip in Auckland, the "City of Sails," which hosted the exciting 2000 America's Cup Challenge.


